BYLAW NO. 1703

A Bylaw to Amend "Fire Department Bylaw,
1989, No. 1561, to Prohibit Outside Burning.

WHEREAS the Fire Chief has recommended the banning of all outside burning since there is a composting system, since we want to avoid creating additional air pollution and we want to avoid ongoing nuisances for neighbours;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Duncan enacts in open meeting as follows:

1. Insert the following new Section 26. into the "Fire Department Bylaw, 1989, No. 1561:

"26. All outside burning (i.e. open or contained fires excluding barbecues) is prohibited."


2. Renumber existing clause 26. to number 27. and renumber the balance of the sections in Bylaw 1561 accordingly.
3. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Fire Department Bylaw, 1989, No. 1561, Amending Bylaw, 1993, No. 1703.

READ FOR THE SECOND TIME on the 25th day of January, 1993.

READ FOR THE THIRD TIME on the 25th day of January, 1993.
